1 NUMBER OF PUBLICATIONS

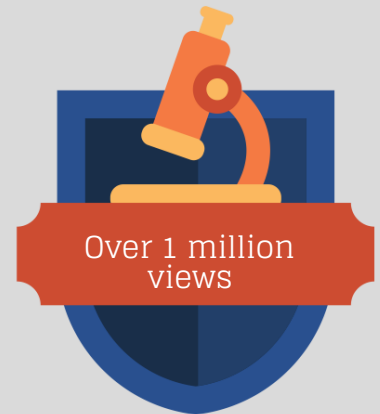
In the past 16 years women scientists in the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences published over 6,000 scientific articles, 800 review articles and over 130 books/book chapters
